- Must be a strong student in Language Arts with a 90 cumulative average in Language Arts for the 7th Grade-*CMS will look up grades*
- Must have a cumulative average of 80 or above in Science, Social Studies, and Math
- Must have good organization skills
- Must have good time management skills
- Must be a responsible student that turns in **all homework** on time- No late work is accepted in accordance with the High School Foreign Language policy; students without completed homework receive an automatic zero.
