All personal information submitted to the McFarland Fund Scholarship Committee is confidential and used solely by the Committee in determining scholarship awards. All material submitted is secured and subsequently shredded.

Applications must include the following credentials and be received or mailed with a readable post mark no later than **March 1st**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered under any circumstance.

1. The *completed signed* application form
2. A typed 250 word essay
3. Official high school or college transcript (copies are acceptable)
4. ACT, SAT, or any other aptitude or achievement test scores unless already attending college (copies are acceptable)
5. Three letters of recommendation
6. Financial information described above
