William T. Meyers was born in Pilot Point, Texas and attended the University of North Texas where he received a composite science teaching degree. After graduation he taught science in Dallas for 2 years. He then joined the U. S. Navy and became a Naval Aviator. Mr. Meyers attained a Masters Degree in Meteorology from the Naval Postgraduate School. He served in the Navy for 27 years attaining the rank of Navy Captain.

Upon retirement from the U. S. Navy, Mr. Meyers returned to teaching. He began teaching at Carroll Senior High School in 1994, where he first taught Physical Science and then Physics. He served for part of this time as the Science Department Chairman and was selected as Teacher of the Year by his peers for school year 1997-98. Mr. Meyers was the assistant varsity softball coach for eight years.

Mr. Meyers believed and lived by the motto "Do the right thing, because it is the right thing to do." He was highly respected by his peers for his integrity, leadership and high moral convictions.

Mr. Meyers was married to Raynelle Meyers, a CISD employee, was the father of 2 children, Aaron and Amanda (a 1998 CSHS grad), and had one granddaughter.

Mr. Meyers believed education was one of the keys to success in life. He strived to instill the desire to learn to his students. He wanted to teach his students to use critical thinking skills that would serve them throughout their lives long after subject matter was forgotten. This scholarship will be awarded to a student demonstrating high moral character and one who will have completed 4 years of high school science. The scholarship will be dedicated in his memory to assist a student in their pursuit of higher education.
