

# Extra Credit

## Rules and Regulations

Extra credit may be earned by finding grammar or spelling mistakes in the following places:

- newspapers, magazines, books, anything printed
- billboards or signs on buildings
- television/radio

Here's how it works:

1. Find a mistake in any printed media. Perhaps you will find a word misspelled or a verb and subject that do not agree.
2. Cut out the example. Paste it on a sheet of paper, highlight the error, and include the following:
  - the name of the publication
  - the date of the publication
  - the page number where you found the error
  - what the correct usage should be

If the error is on a billboard or sign, write where and when you saw the billboard, what the error was and what the correct usage should be.

3. If you hear an error on television or the radio, write the following on a piece of paper:
  - the name of the television or radio show
  - the date and time of the show
  - what the error was
  - what the correct usage should be

4. You may submit **one error, once a week – only on Fridays**. For each verified error you find (once a week) you will get one extra 100 daily grade. **NOTE: If you do not follow all the instructions exactly, you will not receive credit. This is very important!**

5. If you catch any error I make (and I, like everyone else, make errors), you will get one extra 110 daily grade.
