# Heat Stress

Protect yourself against excessive heat exposure. Drink plenty of water, wear loose, light colored clothing and take frequent breaks in a cool area or shade. Monitor yourself and others for signs and symptoms of Heat Stress.

## Heat Exhaustion

**The body's response to an excessive loss of water and salt through sweating, person skin may appear to look wet, white and weak**

### Symptoms:

- Rapid heart beat
- Heavy sweating
- Extreme weakness and fatigue
- Nausea, possible vomiting
- Dizziness
- Irritability
- Moist skin, slightly elevated body temperature

### First Aid for Heat Exhaustion:

- Rest in cool, shaded place
- Drink cool water slowly
- Lie down with feet raised 8 to 12 inches
- Loosen clothing
- Place cool compress on forehead and under arms

## Heat Stroke

**A serious medical condition that occurs when the body can no longer regulate its core temperature; sweating stops and the body cannot get rid of excess heat**

### Symptoms:

- Mental confusion, delirium, fainting or seizures
- High body temperature
- Hot, dry skin, usually red or bluish color
- Loss of coordination
- Throbbing headache

### First Aid for Heat Stroke:

- *Call 911 and request immediate medical assistance*
- Move victim to a cool, shaded area
- Remove excess clothing
- Soak the victim in cool water
- Place cold packs under arm pits
