

# Yearbook Club Application

Things to know before you apply to Yearbook Club:

We will meet after school on Tuesdays. It will last until 4:20, but if you sometimes have to leave a little earlier that will be fine. If there is another club that meets regularly on Tuesday afternoons, you will have to choose one or the other. You will need to be creative and to work well with other club members.

The yearbook is all done online, so you will need to be comfortable using a computer. It's helpful to have internet access at home but not required. It's also helpful to have a digital camera that you are allowed to bring to school (not a cell phone with a camera). You should know how to use the camera and know how to download the pictures onto a computer. We do own a couple of cameras that students can check out for the day if they don't have one. Buying a camera is NOT required.

Yearbook club is fun, but it's also a bit of work. You might be assigned to take photos of another club, and then you would need to be able to go to that club a couple of times during the year on different days than Yearbook Club. You will also be assigned a class to take pictures of, so you would need to be confident talking to different teachers and to students you don't know.

We will have our last meeting on March 6<sup>th</sup> (unless the deadline changes for some reason) but will schedule a party in late May to get a "sneak peek" at the yearbooks when they are delivered.
