Dress supplies (deliver to art room)

- Standard size pillow cases (especially ones with patterns, lace details, etc.)
- 1/2 inch ribbon (for the arm hole finish)
- Ribbon, Ribbon, Ribbon!!! (each dress needs two 30" length ribbon for the shoulder ties)
- Irons (we will need 4-6)
- Thread
- Small patterned fabric for details and dress trim
- Lace for dress trim
- Buttons for details
- Fleece for details
- Rick Rack for details
