



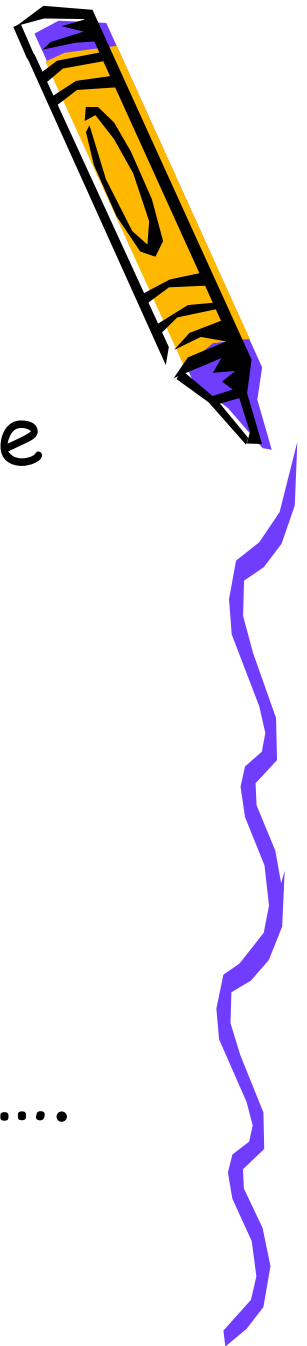

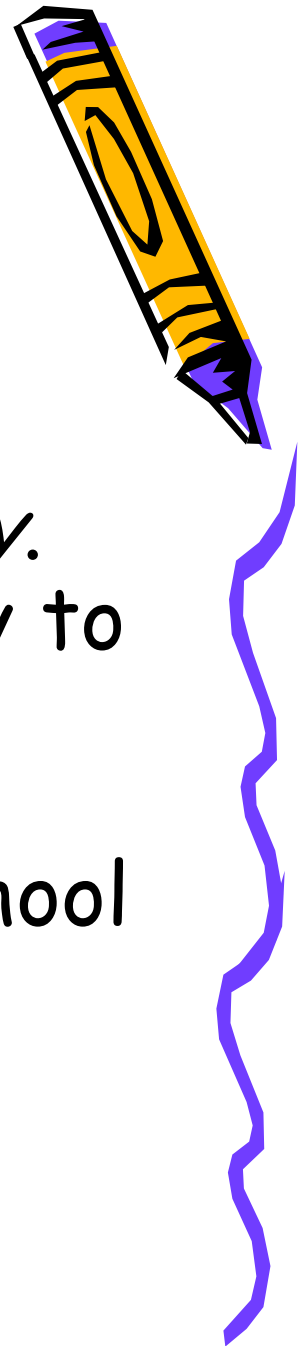


# JES Volunteer Code of Ethics 2009-2010 School Year

- Please be dependable. The teachers are planning activities for you and the students. Please always communicate with the teachers if you are not able to make it.



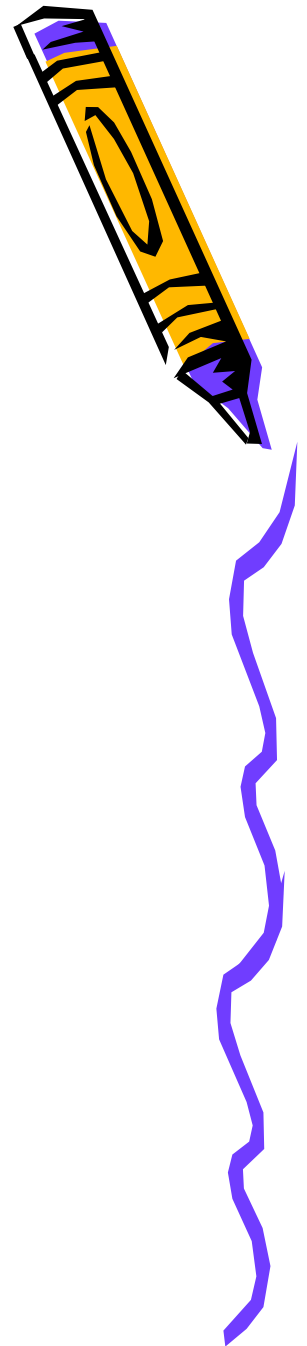
# Communication

- Please keep the door leading into the Teacher's Lounge closed.

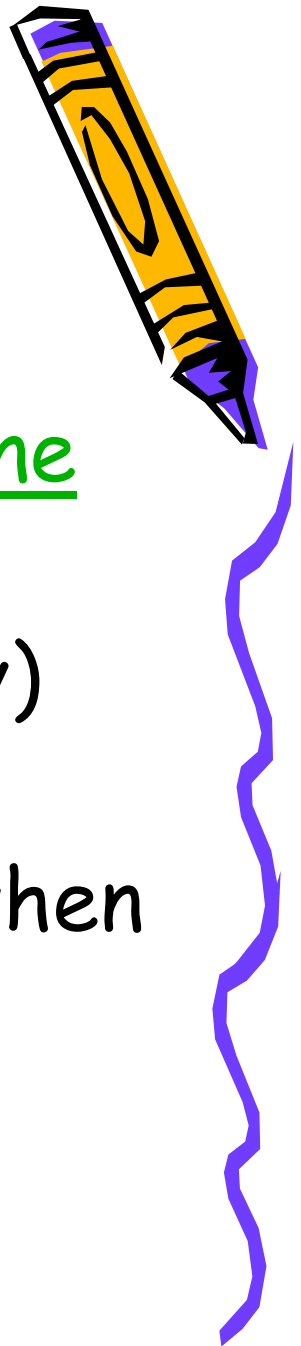


# H1N1 Virus Precautions
