

Safety Patrol

Description: Children are “on duty” during arrival and/or dismissal times.

Their responsibilities include:

- Monitor entrances and hallways.
- Assist teachers in supervising the cafeteria and gym prior to AM bell.
- Raise and lower the flag.
- Greet arriving children in the carpool circle.
- Clear classrooms at end of the day for bus departure.

When: AM session – 7:35 to 8:00, PM session – 2:40 to 3:05

Dates: Every day during assigned session

Semester: Children are assigned duty for a 4-6 week session. They will be assigned AM and/or PM duties depending on how many children participate. You will be notified as to the session your child has been assigned.

Parental Involvement Required: None

Transportation Issues:

- Children assigned to AM duty will need transportation arrangements as their duty begins prior to bus arrival. (7:35am)
- Children assigned to PM duty will need transportation arrangements as their duty ends after bus departure. (3:05pm)

Enrollment Limitations: Safety patrol is a privilege that the children must earn. Teacher recommendation and no behavior or work habit marks on their report cards are required.
