

## Summer Reading

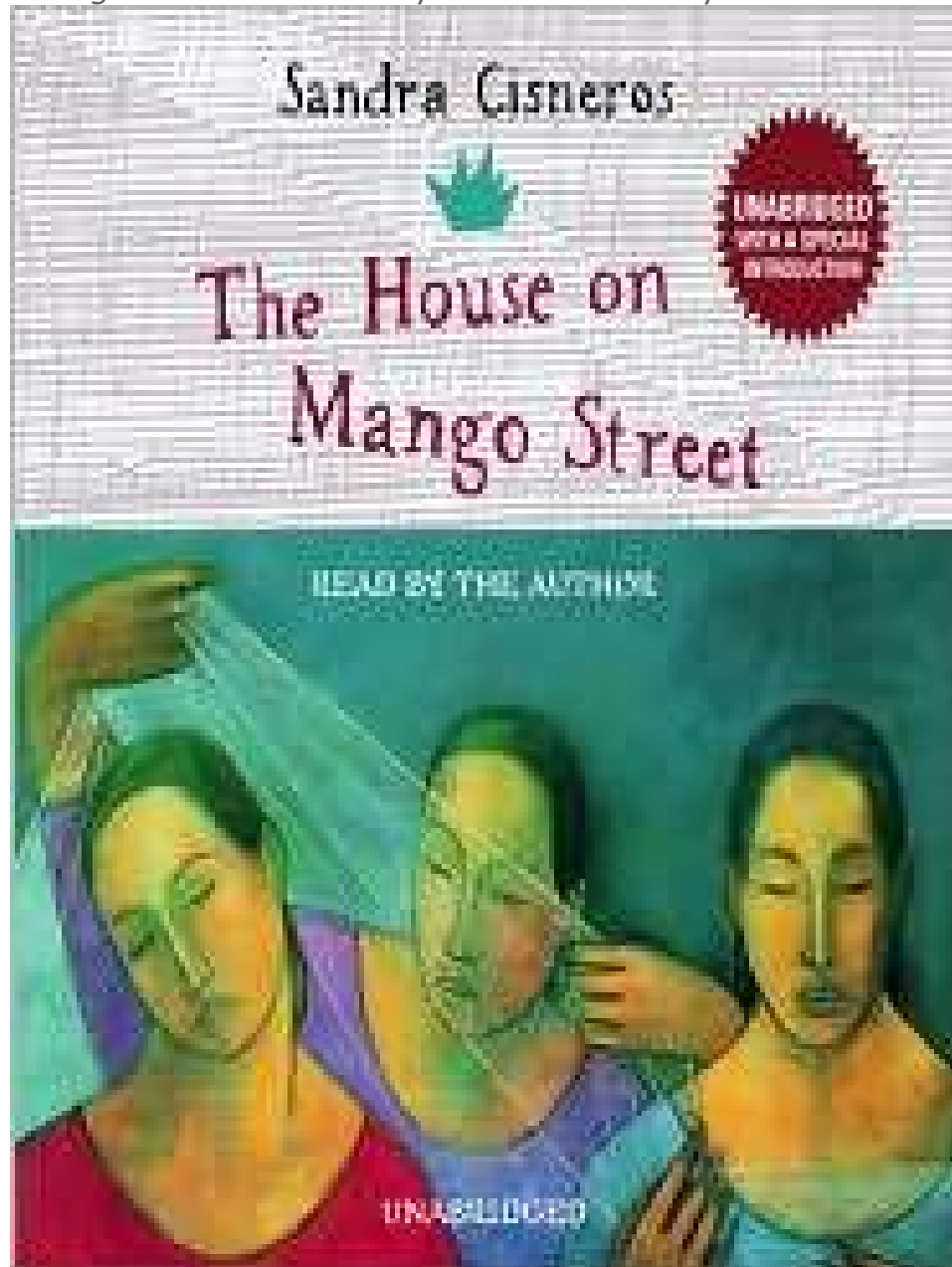
**Basic English I** – Carroll High School – Mrs. McNay
