Driver's Education Program**

Basic Driver's Education Information

- The Driver's Education Program at Carroll High School require students to complete 3 law classes before taking the written test at the DMV for their learners permit. The classes will be held at Carroll High School from 4pm-8pm on the following dates- Monday April 4th, Tuesday April 12th, Monday April 19th.
- Make up classes (for absences) are held every Monday though Thursday from 7am to 8am at the high school.
- Parents must document 20 hours of driving with their child before receiving their driving test. We will provide a log sheet.
- Summer classes will be Monday through FRIDAY starting June 6th and ending June 29th.
- Two consecutive hours a day are required (one hour of classroom instruction followed by one hour of driving)
- Students must be 15 years old before June 6th 2010.
- Total cost for the program is \$325. The full amount or a deposit of \$100 must be paid to reserve your 2-hour time block (first come first serve basis.)
- Please make checks payable to: Carroll ISD. This money is non-refundable.
- At the completion of this program, students will receive a certificate that may entitle them to a 10 % discount with most insurance agencies.
- Students will be driving brand new 2010 cars or trucks.
- This program can be scheduled around summer school/ camps/ tournaments/ and short vacations.

The Driver's Education Program includes:

- Practice questions for the written test
- Street Lessons for student driver's
- A driving range in a controlled area
- A minimum of 32 hours of classroom instruction and 7 hour behind the wheel.
- All instructors are certified through the Texas Education Agency.
