Sign Up Now for State Required Immunizations

January 26, 9:00am: Durham and Eubanks Intermediate

January 28, 9:00 am: Carroll High and Carroll Senior High

January 29, 9:00 am: Carroll and Dawson Middle

Please plan to take advantage of the Tarrant County Public Health immunization clinic that will be held at your campus. Permission/Consent forms and Vaccination Information Sheets can be downloaded from the CISD webpage under the Health Services Department or the Safety Zone. You may also pick up forms and get further information from your school nurse. **You must fill out a separate consent form for each vaccine given. Please specify in the bottom left corner your requested vaccine on each sheet.** Also, please familiarize yourself with the Vaccine Information Sheet that is specific to the vaccine requested to learn more about the disease.

4 Vaccines Available

Tdap- Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis. Required for entry into 7th grade if it has been 5 years since the last tetanus containing vaccine, also required every 10 years for grades 9-12.

Varicella – Chicken Pox. 2 doses after first birthday are required for entry into 7th grade. No vaccine required if disease documented in school clinic.

Meningococcal – Bacterial Meningitis. 1 dose to enter 7th grade.

HPV – Human Papilloma Virus. Optional for girls 11 years and older; 3 in series.

Cost is \$14.00 for 1 vaccine and \$20.00 for 2 or more; there is no income requirement, all students are eligible. **Cash or checks payable to TCPH along with the corresponding forms must be turned into your School Nurse 2 days before the scheduled clinic.** If you have any questions call your School Nurse.
