Grading System

All grades are recorded numerically. Transfer grades are recorded using the numerical equivalent on the grade of the sending school. The final grade for full-year courses is determined by the average of both semesters.

Change in Reporting Student Rank

After extensive study and consideration, Carroll Senior High School will no longer rank students below the top 10% beginning with the Class of 2011. Texas State law requires all public schools to numerically rank the top 10% of each class.

For the Class of 2019 (through seven semesters), the weighted grade point average for the top ten percent is:

Top 10% 101.11 and above

Grade Weighting and Reporting

Carroll Senior High School reports a weighted grade point average. This average includes all courses taken for high school credit.

Weighted Courses

Honors (H), Gifted (HG), Pre-Advanced Placement (Q), and Advanced Placement (P) courses are weighted per semester.

- All Honors, Gifted and Pre-AP courses will be weighted by 7 points.
- All Advanced Placement courses will be weighted by 10 points.

Computation of weighted grades is done at the completion of the course. Weighted grades are used only in computing the GPA. **Numerical grades on the transcript do not reflect the weighting.**
