

# CISD Student Clinic Assessment for COVID-19 Like Symptoms

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Today your child presented to the school health clinic with one or more COVID-like symptoms, as indicated below. In accordance with the Texas Education Agency (TEA) and Tarrant County Public Health (TCPH) guidelines, your child must be sent home for additional monitoring and observation. It is strongly recommended that you 1) isolate your child at home, 2) avoid unnecessary contact with others, and 3) contact your child's physician for further guidance. Your school nurse or other designated person will provide ongoing communication and assistance with determining when your child may safely return to school. The TEA/TCPH criteria for returning to school are summarized below.

## **COVID-19 Like Symptoms** (*check all that apply*):

- Fever
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing or, in a diagnosed asthmatic or chronic allergic student, a change in baseline
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Abdominal pain
- Abnormal taste or smell
- New onset of severe headache

## Additional relevant symptoms (*check all that apply*):

- Fatigue
- Chills
- Congestion or runny nose
- Significant muscle pain or ache
- Nausea

## **Return to School Criteria:**

Students with COVID-19 like symptoms and/or a positive COVID-19 test, may return to school when **ALL 3** of the following criteria have been met:

1. The student's temperature has been less than 100 degrees fahrenheit for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medication;
2. The student's symptoms have improved; and
3. At least 10 days have passed since the symptoms first appeared.

A student may return to school before all of the above criteria have been met, **IF** you either (a) obtain a medical professional's note clearing the student for return based on an alternative diagnosis or (b) obtain an acute infection test that comes back negative for COVID-19.
