Emergency Operations Plan

- First developed as a Crisis Plan in 1999 with input from Southlake and Grapevine Police, Fire and City officials, American Red Cross, DFW Airport staff, nurses, campus/central office administrators and counselors represented
- Evaluated and updated regularly; latest in 2015
- Sent to all employees as PDF for placement on computer desktop
- Includes 31 different crisis scenarios in a notebook with section dividers (copies for principal, AP nurse, counselor)
- Ongoing tabletop training exercises conducted with SL DPS and District Leadership Team (DLT)



EOP Components

- **Mitigation/Prevention** - reducing or eliminating risk to life and property
- **Preparedness** - planning for the worst-case scenario
- **Response** - taking action during a crisis or emergency
- **Recovery** - restoring the learning and teaching environment after an event



DRILLS

- Evacuation
- Reverse Evacuation
- Severe Weather (Take Shelter)

- Lockdown (soft perimeter/hard lockdown)

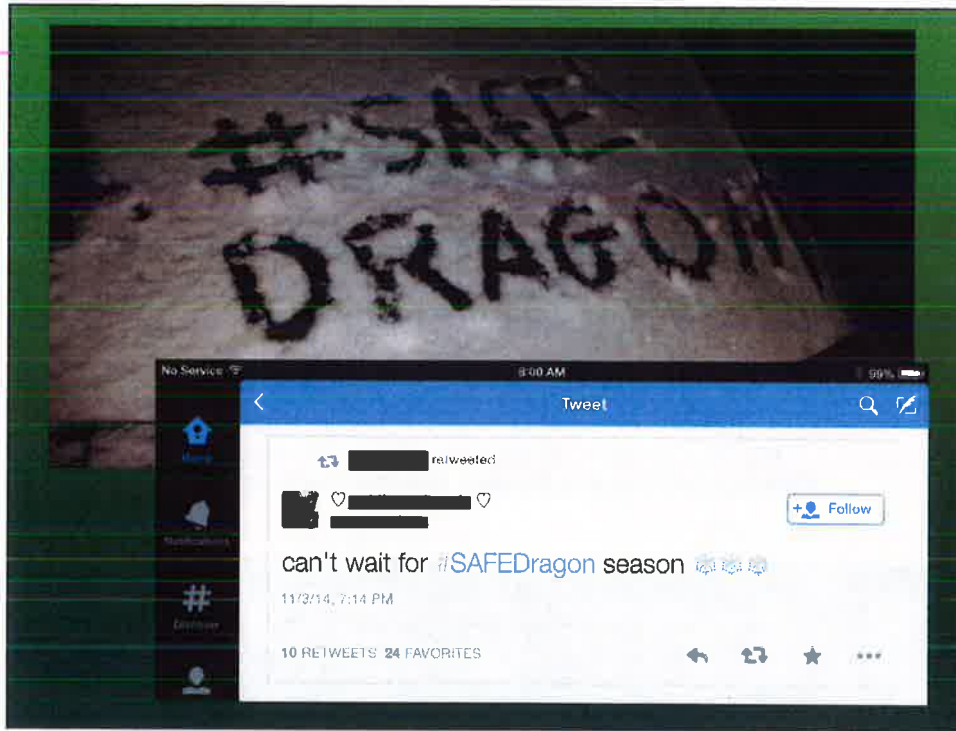
Safety Initiatives Funding Sources

More About Operation #SAFEdragon



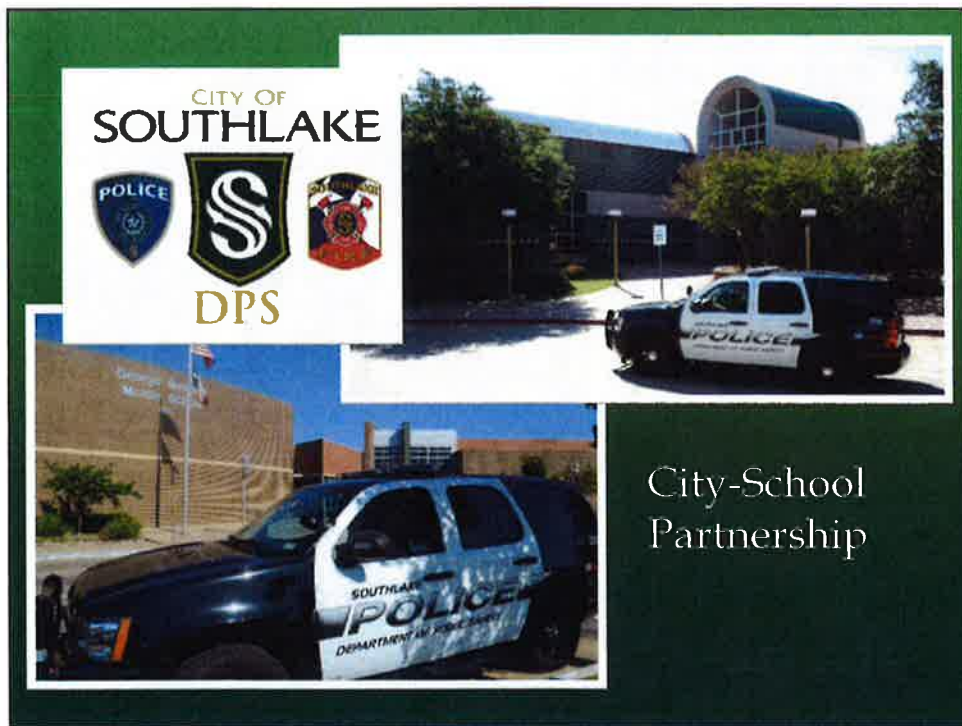
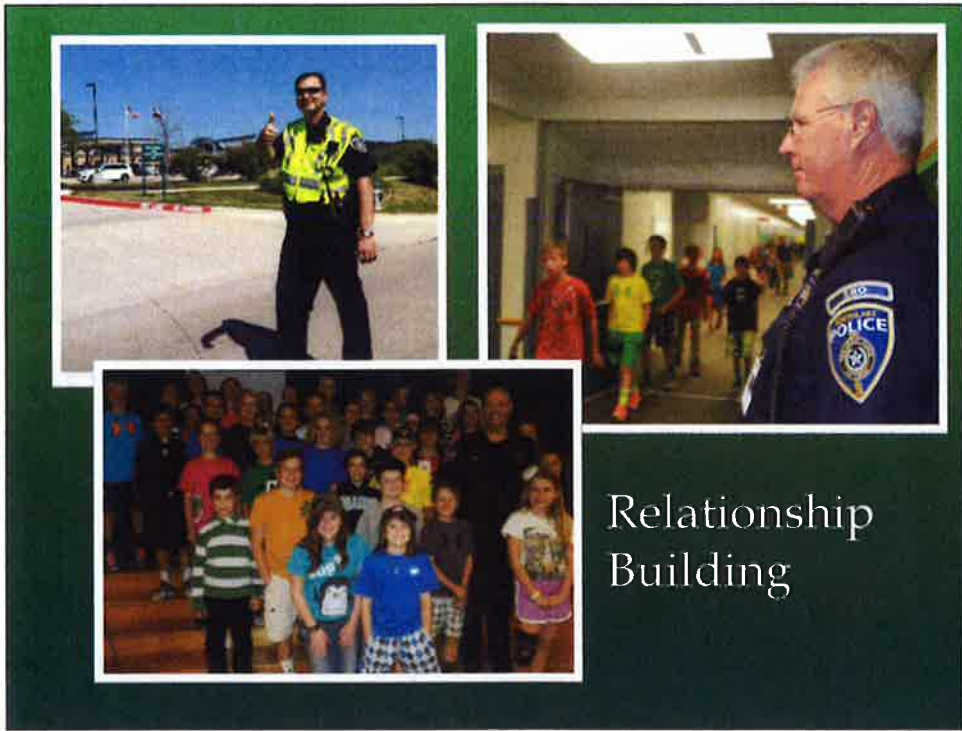
- The absence of a safe and secure environment means learning WILL NOT happen.

More About Operation #SAFEdragon



- Crime Control Prevention District (CCPD) represented on Mayor's Safety Task Force
- Southlake CCPD recommended funding for enhanced program
- \$240,000 General Fund; \$660,000 CCPD - Personnel, Equipment, Training



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- Pandemic health preparation and education
- Preventive Health initiative: Annual CISD Shot Clinic, CPR AED program, Exclusion policy awareness and continuity of care throughout CISD clinics
- SRO/Nurse partnership in a medical emergency and daily student assessments

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2009 Bond Program

- Video cameras to monitor issues and the necessary infrastructure.
- Access Control - Student and Staff ID badges serve as key-swipe cards, as well.
- Raptor Technology checks visitors to campus against sex offender database.

More About Operation #SAFEdragon



- 2009 Bond Program added security entrances "man-traps" at all CISD campuses.
- Phase 1 of #SAFEdragon included playground fencing (RES/CES/JES), cell boosters and additional safety signage at campuses.
- Facility maintenance, campus traffic flow, digital radio communications, bus safety and volunteer background checks are key components.



#SAFEdragon Possibilities

- Additional video surveillance cameras to protect CISD assets (one issue is equity among campuses)
- Additional key card swipe systems at various CISD locations
- Video equipment/buzzer system for main school entrances
- Additional fencing as recommended for schools
- More cell boosters for dead zones in CISD campuses/facilities
- Bullet proof glass at CISD main entrances/facilities
- Communication technologies & emergency lighting systems for classroom
