

OVERVIEW	Permission to park on campus in a designated Carroll Independent School District parking area is considered a student privilege that may be revoked under certain conditions of misconduct by the student driver.
CREDENTIALS	<p>A student must present a valid driver's license, vehicle registration, license plate number and proof of insurance to be eligible for a parking permit. The student's driver's license and insurance must remain current at all times.</p> <p>Students must register the motor vehicle and purchase a parking permit from the campus administration that oversee the campus parking program.</p>
PARKING PERMITS	<p>Any student wishing to park a vehicle in District parking lots must purchase a parking permit. A parking fee, determined by the Board of Trustees, will be assessed. So long as space is available, parking permits may be issued throughout the year.</p> <p>Students will be allowed to purchase one (1) parking permit only and it shall be assigned to the vehicle registered on the application for permit.</p> <p>All parking permits must be displayed when the vehicle is on District property. The permit can only be displayed on the vehicle for which it is registered. Hangar-type permits shall be displayed from the interior rearview mirror.</p>
TEMPORARY PERMITS	In special circumstances, a temporary parking permit may be obtained from the designated campus administrator responsible for the parking lot. The definition for special circumstances and issuance of the temporary parking permit will be at the discretion of the Principal or designee.
REPLACEMENT	In the event a parking permit is lost, stolen, or destroyed, the permit

PERMITS holder shall immediately notify the high school campus administrator responsible for parking.

PARKING
GUIDELINES

Students will not be permitted to:

1. Speed in any District parking lot.
2. Double-park.
3. Park across a white or yellow line.
4. Park in a fire lane.
5. Loiter or sit in parked cars during school hours.
6. Operate the motor vehicle in any way considered unsafe.
7. Park without displaying a parking permit.

Students may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct for violation of this regulation. Cars may be towed, at the owner's expense, for violation of this regulation.

REVOCATION
OF PARKING
PRIVILEGE

Student parking privileges at any campus may be revoked, without refund, for violation of the parking guidelines or any Student Code of Conduct violation that involves the use of a motor vehicle parked on school property.

Students having their parking privileges revoked will not have their parking fees refunded.
